First Mass of Sunday

Advent urges us to stay awake and not sleep through the opportunities life gives us to discover God in our midst. Advent calls us to 'watch' to pay attention to the signs of God's unmistakable presence in our lives, to live expectantly not as a death sentence but as gift from God. The disciple's life is centred in such a 'watchfulness' in 'attentiveness' to the love of God in every joy and sorrow, every pain and trauma, every victory and setback before us.

Our lives are an Advent, a prelude, to the life of God to come. While confronting us with the reality that our lives are finite and fragile, these Sundays of Advent also assure us of the mercy

of God, who is with us in the midst of all the struggles of our everyday Advent journey to the dwelling place of God. Advent challenges us to see our lives not as a disjointed set of experiences and circumstances but as a pilgrimage to the dwelling place of God—a journey in which every moment, every step is a new revelation of God's presence in our midst. God is both the road we travel and the destination of our pilgrimage.

Waiting is a reality of human condition. It is often in waiting that love is realised: In waiting for someone, our own everyday business becomes almost meaningless as we anticipate, worry, and prepare for his or her return. In waiting, we realise our own powerlessness, our deepest hopes and needs, and the gift of the person we are awaiting is to us. Our lives are Advents of waiting: to be healed, to make things better, to complete and move on. Our experiences of such waiting are fulfilled in the Messiah Jesus, who makes our lives whole, who brings healing to those difficult times we all experience.
